Dear Parents,

Kindly make a note of the following points:

- 1. Summer vacation for the ongoing session starts from Saturday, 27th April 2019 after 2 p.m. and will end on Sunday, 16th June 2019 5 pm. The boarders will have to report on the 16th of June latest by 5 pm. The school reopens on 17th of June 2019.
- 2. The school has re-designed the Summer Assignments catering to the parents' request to facilitate some leisure time for their children to spend with them. This year each child is given limited work along with revision of the syllabus covered in the month of April 2019. Please insist on your child making a daily schedule to finish holiday assignments well within the time available and also revise the syllabus covered in the month of April 2019. Classes X & XII in order to prepare for the board examinations must try and cover up at least 50% of their syllabus in all the subjects during the summer vacation.
- 3. SYNA Day School has started functioning from this year; the day students will be shifted to separate sections from June onwards so that the studies and activities planned for them can be smoothly conducted.
- 4. Like last year this year too, the school will be organizing the **Annual Exhibitions** in the month of July on the occasion of Foundation Day of the School i.e. **9**th **of July**. The display of exhibits will remain open for a week long time for the parents and people of the town. Soon after the vacation the students will be involved in the creative work of preparing innovative models and exhibits. You are requested to encourage your ward to explore and collect some unique ideas for the exhibitions. The students are welcome to contact their subject teachers during the vacation period regarding the exhibition work.
- 5. From this year CBSE's new pattern of Skill-based learning is adopted where sports and co-curricular activities have been due weightage.
- 6. **Periodic Test-1** will start from **15th of July 2019**, please ensure that your child utilizes the time available to him on revising the syllabus done in the month of April in order to prepare for the exam.
- 7. Please motivate your children to be regular to school and not to miss any class tests or term tests as the marks obtained in these tests carry weightage in the final examinations. According to CBSE norms minimum 75% attendance is mandatory for a student to be eligible to appear in the final examination. Students must not remain absent on account of religious ceremonies, weddings, family tours, birthdays etc. Parents are requested not to ask frequently for taking their wards out on leave. The school has a specific 'leave-policy'. A student can avail a maximum of 5 day leave at a stretch in an academic year which cannot be clubbed with any holidays. You are requested to stick to the holidays and leaves granted and send your children back to school on time.
- 8. We organize interactive sessions with parents (PTMs) of all classes during the course of the academic year. This exercise is undertaken to familiarize parents with school policies regarding academics, examinations, attendance, & co-scholastic assessment and also to address queries of parents. Attendance to orientation sessions is mandatory for both the parents. It will be much appreciated if you could make it convenient to attend these interactive sessions throughout the year which impacts your ward's academic future.
- 9. The **planner** for the session 2019-20 has been given to your ward. It carries the details of tests/ examination, competitions, activities, the list of holidays of the school and the dates of Parent Teacher Meetings. Kindly adhere to the year planner strictly. The school advises the parents to plan their visits to the boarding house strictly as per the planner.
- 10. Parents are requested to ensure the timely payment of the school fee in order to avoid the late fee of Rs. 2000 per month.
- 11. You are requested to carefully read the rules and regulations mentioned in the almanac and abide by them. The first page on 'General Information of the Student' must be filled in by you. The parents of the Day scholars are also expected to check the almanac of their ward every day for any note or circular sent by the teachers and also to acknowledge the same. The boarders' parents are intimated about the daily undertakings through the 'Class Watsapp Groups'. You are requested to insinuate the Class Teacher/Admin of the group in case your name is not added in the group.

- 12. In order to promote the spoken English and public speaking skills we have implemented 'Student's Talk' in the morning assembly through which each student gets a chance to address the assembly as per the turn for class assembly. We recommend you to inculcate reading habits in your children. Kindly encourage your child to read English newspaper daily also ask him/her to choose a book of his/her choice and positively finish reading it during the vacation.
- 13. For an update on the activities of the school we release school magazine-'SYNAPSE' every year on the occasion of the Annual Day of the school. Your suggestions and articles, poetry or the write ups for the forthcoming 'Sixth Edition' are welcome. You are requested to mail them to the Chief Editor, Mr. Kamal Sarecha on kamal.sarecha@synainternational.edu.in
- 14. You are advised to get all the necessary medical check-ups/vaccinations of your ward done during the summer vacation.
- 15. It is recommended that the children must be encouraged by the parents to go for the annual educational tours which facilitate valuable learning lessons for life. The students who went on the tour this year thoroughly enjoyed and have shared their enriching experiences.
- 16. Please check the school website at regular intervals for updates. You can access important circulars, handouts, home works, messages posted by the teachers/school administration.
- 17. The school considers the students as well as the parents to be the brand ambassadors and an important part of the SYNA family. You are requested to recommend the school for the wards of your friends and relatives for quality education. The school will highly appreciate your support and effort. It will be a kind gesture on your part to recommend some good students amongst your acquaintances for admission. Admissions are open for the session 2019-2020.

Finally, I must once again thank you for your continuous support in all our endeavours and hope the same from our new parents who are joining the SYNA family from the session 2019-20. We expect similar encouragement to help us in offering our students the most congenial environment so that their learning becomes easy, useful and everlasting.
