Dear Parents

It has been observed that a lot of day-boarding students are absenting from school every now and then and on Saturdays in particular. The parents of boarding students too have been taking their wards for outings too frequently and it has become a persistent trend to report late invariably after every outing. It goes without saying that each time when a student remains absent from the school he/she misses out on the important lessons and learning that was imparted on that day. Consequently it reflects in the poor performance of the students in the examination. This is to bring to the knowledge of all such students and parents that the CBSE has issued very firm directives against absenteeism. As per the CBSE guidelines a student with less than 75% attendance will not be allowed to appear in any of the CBSE examinations whether board or home. Therefore each single day of attendance is vital for the students. The parents must discourage the tendency of frequent absenteeism in order to ensure a better grooming and learning of their children. Parents must also educate their children about the importance of personal hygiene and respecting the school rules and discipline. The proper uniform, clean handkerchief, clipping of nails, polished shoes etc. must be a regular habit and priority of the students. The school will much appreciate the co-operation of parents.

The board practical examinations will be conducted in the month of January 2024 and the theory exams in the month of February 2024. Home examinations will be conducted as per the dates mentioned in the planner. Promotion to the next class will be based on the cumulative performance in the final exam and the yearly average (Cycle tests & Term 1). The syllabus in the board classes has already been completed and the revision and mock tests are in process. Syllabus completed in other classes is around 80%.

It has been a very distressing experience of school to remind the parents to pay the school fee. The school wants the teachers to focus on the studies of the students which often gets affected owing to the teachers spending time on calling the parents to pay the school fee. Even more upsetting are the offending replies that the teachers receive from some of the parents on being contacted for the fee. The school would never like to send the reminders until they become so genuinely imperative. The fourth installment of fee will be due on 10th of January 2024. A late fee penalty of Rs. 2000 p.m. will be charged thereafter. The parents are requested to make sure that the dues are cleared on or before the due date. SYNA, following the practice of previous years, is organizing 'Winter Study Camp' from Sunday 24th of December 2023 to Sunday 7th of January 2024 in order to provide expert guidance for a sound preparation of board examination. The students will avail the benefit of a meticulously crafted extensive, rigorous study and revision plan perfectly blended with a series of regular tests. The winter study camp has been an extremely successful strategy in terms of the board results. The fee for the study camp is Rs. 7000 (inclusive of meals and stay) which must be

deposited before the beginning of the winter study camp. It is an opportunity for the day boarders and day scholars to get an exposure to the boarding culture as they stay in the campus for the duration of the winter camp. Parents must note that the winter study camp is mandatory for all the students of classes X & XII.

Parents of class X students must realize that their ward has now reached at the most important stage of his/her life, that of career choice. As the mentors/guides of your ward, we are fully aware that this period is extremely crucial and life changing for your ward and hence needs to be dealt with extreme sensibility and sensitivity. This is the time when our children might get misguided or misled by their friends or peer group to go for coaching of competitive exams or for changing school which can adversely affect their future prospects. Children want freedom in teenage and so they pressurize their parents to send them out to study but our past experience and observation reveal that they tend to abuse the freedom and become vulnerable to the pressure situations. Students generally get distracted and start indulging in wrong practices in lack of monitoring. We all are aware about the horrendous situation of suicides in the coaching academies if Kota. We firmly believe that our suggestions and recommendations for your ward are more likely to bear positive fruits as they are based on our past experiences of numerous such cases. Therefore we strongly recommend your interaction with the concerned school authorities/teachers, before arriving on any decisions for your child's higher studies. So do find out the competence and interest of your ward with meticulous deliberation.

Parents must note that the last date of applying for the withdrawal is 15th February after which the fee for I term will be charged.

Diwali holidays will begin from 7th of November to the 19th of November 2023. Boarders must report latest by the evening (5 p.m.) of 19th November. Late reporting will not be accepted. Classes begin from 20th of November 2023. Parents of the boarding students must ensure that their ward is not carrying anything which is forbidden in the hostel. Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones to school. If any student is found with a mobile phone in his/her possession, the mobile phone will be confiscated.

The school feels immensely pleased to apprise you that from this year we have become a part of the Sainik School Society. The school will soon announce the opening of admissions in SYNA Sainik School for the session 2024-25. The admissions will be available for class VI only. The students admitted in SYNA Sainik School will follow an exclusive routine of around 10 hours different from the other students at SYNA and they will be trained for military discipline. The school considers the parents as the brand ambassadors and a part of the SYNA family. It will be a kind gesture on your part to recommend SYNA to your acquaintances for admission.
