Please guide and encourage your ward to go beyond the assigned holiday homework and update with current affairs and news around the world. Soon after the vacation Cycle Tests will be conducted, please ensure that your child utilizes the time available to him on revising the syllabus completed in April and prepare for the exam.
- 4. Books are our best friends. It is very crucial that we inculcate reading habits among the students. Please encourage reading of books and the newspaper at home during the vacation period.
- 5. The boarders need to report on **Tuesday 18th June 2024** latest by **5 pm.** Please ensure timely reporting of your ward to the school. Late reporting will seriously hamper the studies.
- 6. Normal classes will begin from Wednesday 19th June 2024.
- 7. The important inter house activities and Cycle Tests will ensue subsequently.



- 8. Parents must ensure that their ward is not carrying anything which is restricted in the hostel. Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones to school. If any student is found with a mobile phone in his / her possession, the same will be confiscated. The school has EPABX system of communication in the hostels. A boarder is allowed maximum 15 minutes of communication with the parents on every Sunday. We request parents to ensure that their ward abides by school rules.
- 9. The school will organize its 17th Foundation Day and Investiture Ceremony on 9th of July 2024. The student council of 2024-25 will be instituted on this day.
- 10. You will soon receive the planner for the session 2024-25, which gives the details of tests/examination, competitions, activities, the list of holidays and the dates of the Parent Teacher Meetings. Kindly strictly adhere to the year planner.
- 11. All parents must check the school website for regular updates. The parents can access circulars, handouts, home works and important messages on the school web portal.
- 12. The school feels immensely pleased to apprise you that from this year we have begun with admissions in SYNA Sainik School in class VI for the session 2024-25. We will appreciate if you, as brand ambassadors of SYNA, recommend the school to your acquaintances.
- 13. The timely payment of the school fee as per the schedule mentioned will be much appreciated:
 - a) First Quarter: latest by 10th of April
 - b) Second Quarter: latest by 10th of July
 - c) Third Quarter: latest by 10th of October
 - d) Fourth Quarter: latest by 10th of January
